**Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
**Father Cheeyoon's Santa Clara Mass of Thanksgiving**  
**Amos 7:12-15      Ephesians 1:3-14      Mark 6:7-13**

Following in the footsteps of the Prophet Amos and St. Paul, **Fr.
