Simple kindnesses to people that, for the most part, we will never know....but GOD KNOWS. As we emerge from our Covid shut-downs and start to resume our OLD WAYS of living our lives, let us do so generously, never forgetting those who struggle as we prep for our own festive and delicious holidays.
